# Key Responsibilities – General Labourers, The Patchmaster Ltd.

About the position:

Reporting to the Foreman at The Patchmaster Limited, our Labourers work as a team with our Equipment Operators to apply spray patching to asphalt roads in Southern Alberta.

As part of this position, you will be working outside in a general road construction environment. Given our short season you must have a willingness to work 12 hours shifts that may include nights, holidays, and weekends.

We work in a dynamic and ever-changing environment, to ensure the safety of our people and the public you will arrive fit for duty with adequate time before your shift to be prepared for work.

You may be responsible for flagging, swamping and operation of a compactor as part of this role. You will help rake and compact spray patches and stay in constant communication with the Operator of the spray patch truck on the progress of the spray patch and road conditions. In addition, you will help with flagging and traffic management as assigned.

## Labourers

### Requirements

- Participate in and apply safety practices and carries out work safely and efficiently in all work you perform.
- Active participation in daily safety meetings contributing ideas and opportunities for continuous improvement.
- Read, understand, and apply site specific instructions prior to directing traffic under supervision of Foreman or Operator
- Ability to setup, reposition and dismantle traffic control signage efficiently, safely and in accordance with site and Alberta Transportation requirements.
- Demonstrate a team first, safety first attitude while working.
- Protect colleagues and the public by keeping work-space free of traffic, and warning oncoming traffic and coworkers of potential hazards.
- Communicate effectively with other workers using established signals and radio equipment to ensure the smooth flow of traffic and minimize confusion.
- Maintain alertness and be fit for work at all times.

- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- A high school diploma or GED an asset
- Reliable transportation to get to and from work.
- Minimum 2 years of experience as a flag person in a construction traffic control. Demonstrated experience or training/certification in traffic control will be an asset.
- Demonstrated knowledge of the safe operation of a compactor is required.
- Must possess a valid class 5 driver's license or above with a clean drivers abstract. Air brakes an asset
- High attention to detail, strong communication skills and ability to follow directions is required.
- Ability to work in varying weather conditions is required.
- Ability to work collaboratively in a team and independently with little supervision is required.
- Valid safety certifications are an asset including first aid certification with CPR.
